## **DECISION**

Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended)
PART OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Proposal:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Hornbeam (carpinus betulus) (T2) - Fell to ground level.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Mixed Group of Trees (G1) - Fell to ground level. situated in garden

of number 10

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 23 August 2019 and decided to **OBJECT** to the following work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Hornbeam (Carpinus betulus) (T2) - Fell to ground level.

## Reasons for objection:

The hornbeam is highly visible within the public realm, is considered to provide a significant level of visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area. The reasons for removal state on the application form are that the tree is damaging a garden wall and gate. This is not considered to be a sufficient reason to justify the removal of a tree that is worthy of being brought under the protection of a tree preservation order and that an



engineering solution should be sought to remedy the situation.

It is recommended that a tree preservation order is served to preserve the visual amenity the tree provides and protect the character of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.

However, the Council would not have any objection to the carrying out of the following works:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Mixed Group of Trees (G1) - Fell to ground level. situated in garden of number 10
