4.7 Lighting Strategy

INTRODUCTION

The sitewide lighting scheme is proposed to be sensitive to the surrounding context including the SINC whilst ensuring safe and secure usage of the site. Any site lighting should be directed away from the woodland.

The proposed accessible stairways and footpaths will include lighting whether that be by bollards of wall mounted lighting for safe movement along routes to the proposed development entrances.

The gardens will also include Iwall mounted domestic lighting. Wall-mounted lighting is proposed within the private gardens, private courtyards and service areas of the proposed residences.

This lighting strategy is subject to further assessment by a lighting specialist.
