The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The proposed rooftop extension, by reason of its siting, size and design, would appear as an overbearing and incongruous addition to the host building, and would thereby detract from the character and appearance of the host building, the street scene and the wider area, contrary to the aims of Policy D1 of the Camden Local Plan.
- 2 The proposed front parapet wall, by reason of its design and appearance, would detract from the original design of the host building and that of the other buildings in the wider area, which would be to the detriment of the character and appearance of

the host building, the street scene and the wider area, contrary to the aims of Policy D1 of the Camden Local Plan.
