Holly. Located outside number 34 to reduce down to 1 foot above previous reduction points. Volume of material to be removed will be approximately a third of its height.

Pin Oak. Located in the middle of the communal area. Removal of approximately 5% of crossing and rubbing branches will result in a 5% thin all round.

Oak. Located on Highgate Hill West has a lot of deadwood and weak branches. We intend to remove just the deadwood.					
T6:					
Ash. Located at the rear of number 1, this tree needs some general maintenance. We intend to cut back the lowest NE facing branches of the tree from the bay tree that is underneath it. This will give it a clearance of the bay by about 2/3 feet. We also intend to remove major rubbing branches that run throughout the tree and approximately 5% of epicormic growth so as to allow more light through for the shrubs below.

Oak. Located at the rear of number 2, this needs a general maintenance (GMS), which includes the removal of 5% of epicormic growth below crown break. On further inspection of this tree, it has a massive cavity in the centre that needs inspecting.
