				Removal of the overly large trees will improve slope stability due to the lelandii debris more readily blocking the drainage system. Their continued presence represents more of a risk to the hydrological stability (n.b., the trees themsleves are not on the slope of Swain's Lane nor Hillway so local slope stability cannot be an issue).
				A more sustainable solution is the proposed planting of different species that do not dominate the local environment and offer very few benefits.
