A samples of materials as appropriate, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority:

Unfortunately the condition doesn't state which material samples should be submitted. However, the agent has submitted a document the clearly shows the facing materials that they would like to use to implement the scheme.

All the materials, including roof tiles, down pipes, stone and lead, comply with those stipulated on the original consent and are of sufficient quality.

The proposed works will not harm the special interest of the grade-II-listed building.

The site's planning history has been taken into account in making this decision.

Special attention has been paid to the desirability of preserving the special interest of the listed building, under s.16 of the Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act 1990 as amended by the Enterprise and Regulatory Reform Act (ERR) 2013
