Background

On 15 June 2018 full planning permission (ref: 2017/3847/P) was granted for the redevelopment of the 3.26 hectare site located off Chalk Farm Road, adjacent to Juniper Crescent and Gilbeys Yard in Chalk Farm, Camden. On 7 January 2020 a S73 application was submitted (ref:2020/0034/P) to vary Condition 4 (approved drawings) for

redevelopment of the petrol filling station site and main supermarket site; namely for a single storey temporary food store on the Petrol Filling Station site with associated parking, servicing, access and landscaping. This application seeks Advertisement Consent to display 2 x fascia signs above the entrance to the proposed Morrisons temporary supermarket.

Proposal

Two fascia signs are proposed on the northern and eastern elevation of the temporary store. Detailed dimensions and aesthetics are clearly illustrated in the supporting documentation and can be found below:

- Petals to have 3mm yellow satin 2T72 faces with 5mm returns (@90mm).
 Morrisons & Since text to have 3mm green satin 6T1F faces with 5mm returns (@90mm).
- All to be complete with Router cut 10mm foamex backs (white for the petals and black for the text).
- All to be mounted onto 32 x 32mm aluminium U section frame, powder coated TBC
- To be internally illuminated with Tetra minimax 7100K.

The northern elevation sign will be located 3800mm from ground level and the eastern elevation sign will be located 3700mm from ground level. Both signs will have the following dimensions:

Depth: 120mmWidth: 6178mmHeight: 3159mm

It is considered that the proposed signage will not have a detrimental effect on public amenity or safety.
