

PLANTING SCHEDULE
Shade-tolerant plants suitable for courtyards



- A**
Liquidambar styraciflua 'Corky'
- Full to light shade
 - Easy to grow
 - Pruning- Remove damaged fronds
 - Small to medium-sized tree up to 12m tall with deeply lobed, glossy green leaves that turn crimson red in autumn.



- B**
Leucothoe axillaris 'Scarletta'
- Dog Hobble
 - Evergreen shrub
 - Light shade / Full sun
 - Good drainage
 - Can reach 1.5M so must be kept pruned
 - Pest free



- C**
Heuchera sp.
- Grows for its attractive colorful foliage
 - Can be positioned in full sun or shade
 - Prune back the leader stem in spring



- D**
Helleborus niger
- Christmas rose
 - Prefers shade
 - Well drained soil
 - Spring flowering
 - Will grow up to 45 cm
 - Prone to aphid attack



- E**
Dryopteris erythrosora
- Japanese Shield Fern
 - Full to light shade
 - Easy to grow
 - Pruning- Remove damaged fronds
 - Prefers moist soil
 - Generally pest & disease free
 - 0.5-1 metre



- F**
Cotoneaster amoenus
- Beautiful cotoneaster
 - Full sun or light shade
 - Produces flowers in summer and berries in autumn
 - Excellent for wildlife



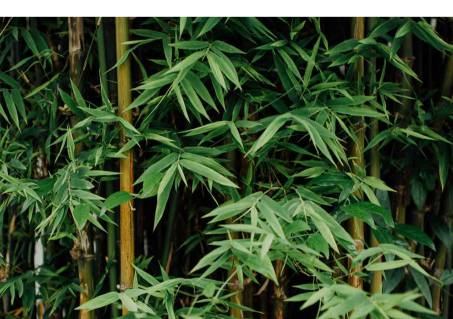
- G**
Buxus sempervirens
- Box hedge
 - Prefers light shade
 - Slow growing
 - Soil should always be slightly moist
 - Box blight is a problem when air flow is restricted
 - UK Native



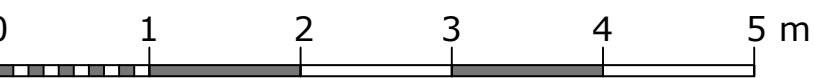
- H**
Dryopteris affinis
- Golden Shield Fern
 - Full to light shade
 - Easy to grow
 - Pruning- Remove damaged fronds
 - Prefers moist soil
 - Generally pest & disease free
 - 0.5-1 metre
 - UK Native



- I**
Blechnum spicant
- Deer Fern
 - Full to light shade
 - Easy to grow
 - Pruning- Remove damaged fronds
 - Prefers moist soil
 - Generally pest & disease free
 - UK Native



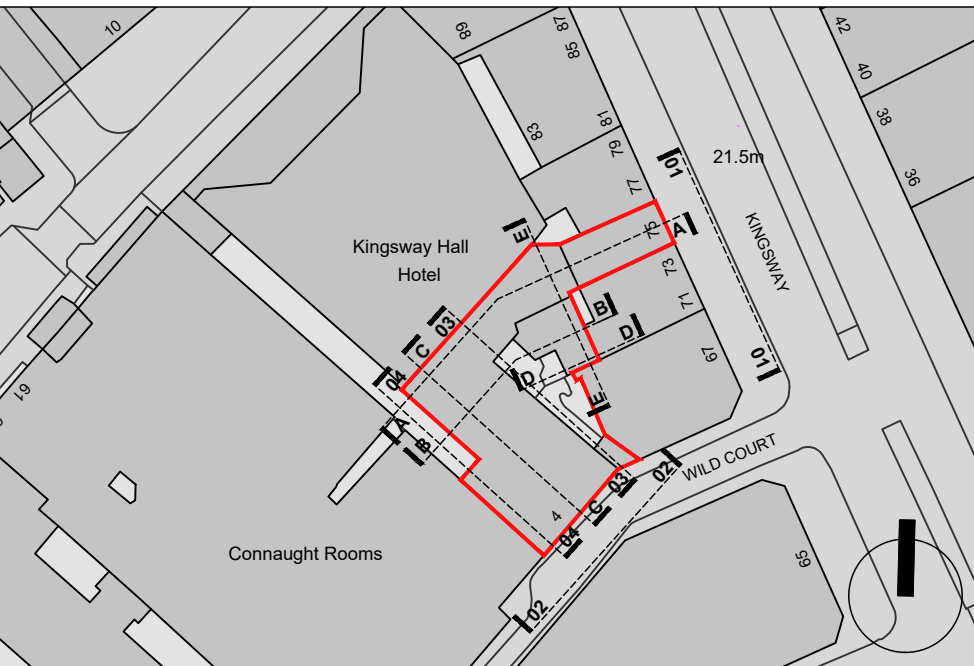
- J**
Bambusoideae
- Light shade
 - Easy to grow
 - Prefers slightly acid, well drained but moist soil
 - Generally pest & disease free
