- 2.) Provide a new location for Refuse Store 2 (This provides waste collection for existing block 65-96 Kiln Place and two new Units 3.1 & 3.2. This quantity has been previously approved under the original planning permission.)
- (3.) Incorporation of 5 new units into the communal waste strategy (Units $1.1-1.4 \& Unit 4 = 5 \times 3Beds$) (N.B Units 1.5, 1.6, 2.1, 2.2 & 6 all remain as individual bins and collection as per approved scheme).
- 2. See above for proposed new location/s for bins from Refuse Store 2 (providing waste collection for existing block 65-96 Kiln Place and two new Units 3.1 & 3.2 - as previously approved under original planning permission)
- Single Unit 4 to be assimilated into Refuse Store 3 as agreed. Incorporation of remaining 4 new units (Units 1.1-1.4) into Refuse Store 1 + Food Waste of Unit 4. Camden's Environment Service technical guidance for recycling and waste 2018 (page 3) requires: 120L General Waste, 140L Recycling & 23L Food Waste per house (up to 3 bedrooms) with a weekly collection. Therefore the incorporation of 4 additional units (+ food waste for Unit 4) generates an additional:
 - 480L General Waste
 - 560L Mixed Recycling
 - 115L Food waste
