2019/5755/L	[REDACTED]	26/01/2020 14:58:56	OBJ	<p>I am objecting the granting of retrospective planning approval for the electrical cupboards/enclosures.</p> <p>I am not objecting to the installation of handrails.</p> <p>The electrical cupboards/enclosures are out of keeping with the grade 2 listed building and are very unsightly, pose a health safety risk to residents and other users of communal staircase and prevent large items of furniture being moved up and down the stairs. The cupboards protrude out at head height and I have to remember to duck to avoid hitting my head every time I pass by the enclosures. The enclosures substantially reduce the available space to move large items such as white goods up and down the stairs.</p> <p>The applicant has not engaged with residences to explain why these cupboards are necessary or on the design.</p>
2019/5755/L	[REDACTED]	24/01/2020 15:47:51	SUPC	<p>I think the encasement boxes should be painted black and that the rails should ideally be black cast iron to fit in with the old railings on the stairways, as this is a listed building and a huge amount of effort has been made to keep the original features where possible.</p> <p>If this is not possible then I would suggest that the metal fixtures are black (they are currently white and stand out because all our other metalwork here is black. I live on the third floor and do not require railings. I would request that unless the people on my landing or the landing above have requested them that they be only fitted to the level required. I think the ones currently fitted look ugly and very out of place.</p>
