Summary Statement:

The site is presently occupied by a vacant and derelict single-storey building, previously used as a church and community meeting place. The Christian Community, a church founded in 1922 in Switzerland built this church in 1948 as a temporary place of worship. An initial 10 year licence for the site was granted. Its use dwindled and the Church Hall was deconsecrated in May 2013.

The building comprises two main rooms, amounting to a GIA of 230sqm presently reached via gates on either side of the building. The building is of standard 1940's prefabricated construction, containing asbestos, and is largely dilapidated. Access to the interior of the building is currently blocked.

The site also contains a shed and a free-standing garage.
