IN GROUNDS FRONT & SIDE: Group including Cherry and Elder - Fell to ground level. 1 x Cherry (T1) - Fell to ground level.

Group including Birch and Rowan (TG1) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 12 November 2019 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

These trees are highly visible from a public place. They are considered to provide a significant level of visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area.

The application alleges that the trees are causing subsidence in the adjacent building. No level monitoring demonstrating a seasonal pattern of subsidence and recovery has been submitted with the supporting documents and the evidence is therefore considered insufficient to demonstrate that the damage is caused by the presence of these trees.



A tree preservation order has been served to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and preserve the character of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
