## REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Silver Birch (T1) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your application dated 05 December 2019 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

- The birch is highly visible within West Hill Park. It is considered to provide a significant level of visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area.
  - The application give the proximity of the tree to the house as a reason for wishing to remove the tree however this is not considered to be a sufficient reason to remove a tree that is considered worthy of protection under a TPO.
  - The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and preserve the character of the conservation area.
