I refer to your letter received by the GLA on 8 January 2020 consulting the Mayor of London on the above planning application, under the terms of the Mayor of London Order 2008.

The applicant proposes: Variation of Condition 4 (approved drawings) of planning permission 2017/3847/P dated 15/06/2018 (as amended by 2019/6301/P dated 24/12/2019, 2019/0153/P dated 06/02/2019 and 2019/2962/P dated 04/07/2019) for redevelopment of the petrol filling station site and main supermarket site; namely for a single storey temporary food store on the Petrol Filling Station site with associated parking, servicing, access and landscaping.

I have assessed the details of the application and, given the scale and nature of the proposals, conclude that the amendments do not give rise to any new strategic planning issues.

Therefore, under article 5(2) of the above Order the Mayor of London does not need to be consulted further on this application. Your Council may, therefore, proceed to determine the application without further reference to the GLA. I will be grateful, however, if you would send me a copy of any decision notice and section 106 agreement.
