We are not sure whether responses will still be collected to this application, but would like to add our view to the record, as property owners in number 14 Belsize Park Gardens.

We are vehemently opposed to the proposal and especially to the removal of the large plane tree (T1) in the rear of 28 Glenilla Road.

There seems no legitimate basis for the proposal, given

- there is minimal damage in 16 Belsize Park Gardens, classified as "slight" in the applicant's report and with no damage perceived by the basement flat residents who have been in place for ten years;
- it is unclear whether the cause of this damage even relates to any nearby vegetation;
- the trees are a major asset to this conservation area.
