Details of a Sustainable Urban Drainage system as required by condition 14 of planning permission reference 2015/6106/P (dated 29/03/2017) for demolition and replacement of the dwellinghouse, as amended by planning reference 2018/4896/P (dated 9 sept 2019).

The Council has considered your application and decided to approve details.

Informative(s):

1 Condition 14 requires details of a sustainable urban drainage system, based on demonstrating 50% attenuation of all runoff, to be submitted for approval prior to commencement of works on site.

In response to comments from the sustainability officer, the original submission

was supplemented by a completed SuDS proforma and an engineer's commentary which sets out further details of the attenuation arrangements, which are based on 37m3 of attenuation tanks. Although the submission does not demonstrate how the SUDs hierarchy has been applied to the site, given the fact that this is a single family dwelling and the proposed 5.0l/s discharge reduces the current 1:1yr event by 75%, the proposals are acceptable.

The submitted details meet the requirements of policies CC1, CC2 and CC3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan June 2017, and are acceptable to discharge the condition.

2 You are reminded that conditions 6 (cycle storage), 9 (landscaping) and 14 (photovoltaic cells) all require details to be submitted and approved before commencement of above ground work. Condition 4 (materials) requires details to be submitted for approval prior to the relevant works.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2019.
