2020/0569/T	Michael Yianneskis	18/02/2020 07:39:49	COMMNT	<p>The tree concerned is a truly iconic tree in a conservation area, and a focus and/or home for local wildlife.</p> <p>It is not entirely clear to me from the documents attached to the application that the tree comprises the main, or indeed a main contribution to the subsidence damage noted in the property (2 Honeybourne Road).</p> <p>Since the two other trees that were located closer to the property than the one referred to in this application have now been cut to ground level, there should be a re-examination of the effect of the removal of these on the subsidence, as soon as possible.</p> <p>Every effort should be made to ascertain that removal of the particular tree will indeed address the subsidence issue before proceeding with the proposed removal of the tree.</p>

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
