# Listed Building Consent Application | Revision 16th February 2020

#### Overview

We applied for listed building consent to proceed with renovation works at Flat 3 10 Lyndhurst Gardens NW3 5NR, which we are renovating and joining to our current flat.

Upon taking advice our application stated we would retain the original wooden flooring in the back room.

### Revision

However upon closer inspection (ie the carpet was taken up) when the works started last week, it was noticed that the flooring is not fit-for-purpose and has;

- A variety of large patchworks repairs
- The existing floor is extremely thin (and won't last even one sanding)
- The floor is in very bad condition (ie has hundreds of small nails sticking out) and is pitted with old holes
- The flooring is too old and decrepit to keep. It is past repairing.

We therefore request that we replace the floor with new wooden flooring.

A mansion weave design would be in keeping with the ceiling design.

- Images of the patchwork of repairs
- Image of the very thin existing original wood
