**Kings' Cross Central Development Site
Application for a Non-Material Amendment to a Planning Permission**

I am writing on behalf of King's Cross Central General Partner Limited (KCCGPL), the owner and developer of the King's Cross Central development site.

KCCGPL has submitted an application today pursuant to Section 96A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) for a non-material amendment to Reserved Matters approval in respect of Building T1, within development zone T (ref. 2013/0405/P) dated 22 March 2016. The proposed non-material amendment seeks the changing of material of the cladding on the northern elevation, from the approved GRC (glass fibre reinforced concrete) to a bronze anodised finish. The selected finish and design is in keeping with the palette of the Building T1 facades and the panelling arrangement and joints matches the building's original design concept.
