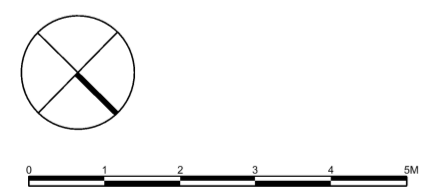


1. Earth
