Dear Rachel English

I do not object to most of the proposed development at the rear of the sorting office, but any attempt to distort the design of the façade of this historically important Grade II listed Victorian building cannot be supported.

I live just round the corner from the building and I would hate to see the intrusion of the roofs from the development at the rear.

Looking closely at the plans I can see there are very faint dotted lines that indicate that the eaves of two of the roofs of the new development will be visible from the front of the sorting office building, certainly if you are standing on the other side of Leighton Road.

The roofs of the new buildings are a little distance away, but the view of them will destroy the roofline of the Victorian building at the front. To make it clearer I'm attaching one of the drawings with two of the dotted lines enhanced in red.

I hope a redesign of these buildings is possible, reducing the height or width of the roofs. Failing that I ask for this application to be refused.

Please confirm receipt of this objection, and inform me of the date of the hearing, of there is to be one.
