The Marx Grave Trust, as the owner of the Marx family grave in the Highgate (East) Cemetery (please see the attached location and site plans), proposes to carry out work to restore the monument to Karl Marx damaged by vandals in February 2019. We propose to contract the conservators Taylor Pearce to restore the inscription panel using marble indents set 30mm into the original surface. New lettering would be incised and filled with lead to match the original inscription partially obliterated by hammer strikes. Epoxy resin would be used to secure any marble or lettering fragments and grout any cracks in the surface. The panel would then be re-installed by Taylor Pearce set slightly back from its original position on a mortar backing. It would be set behind a toughened, non-reflective, anti-UV glass screen fixed to the monument's brick core using steel brackets (please see the attached method statement for full technical details, photographs and drawings).
