

DESCRIPTION

THE COURTYARD SPACE AT GROUND LEVEL IS INTENDED TO CREATE A SIMPLE SPACE THAT CONNECTS HOTEL AND OFFICE. THE COURTYARD ACTS AS AN EXTENSION TO THE HOTEL LOBBY, PROVIDING AN EXTERNAL AREA FOR OUTDOOR SITTING, SET APPROXIMATELY 2m LOWER THAN THE ADJACENT PAVEMENT LEVEL.

A SINGLE SPECIMEN POTTED TREE IS LOCATED ON THE AXIS OF THE MEWS AND COURTYARD SPACES WHICH ACTS AS A FOCAL POINT AT GROUND LEVEL. CLIMBING PLANTS ALONG THE BOUNDARY TO THE GUNMAKERS PUB CREATES A VIBRANT BACKDROP TO THE COURTYARD AREA, PARTICULARLY WHEN VIEWED FROM THE HOTEL LOBBY AND PEDESTRIANS WALKING SOUTH ALONG EYRE STREET PAST THE SUNKEN GARDEN.

THE FEATURE TREE WILL BE IN A LARGE OVERSIZED POT AND WILL PROVIDE A LIGHT AND DAPPLED CANOPY WHICH ADDS A VIBRACY TO THE COURTYARD. PLANTS IN RAISED POTS WILL BE LOCATED THROUGHOUT THE COURTYARD TO HELP ADD TEXTURE AND WARMTH TO THE ENVIRONMENT.
