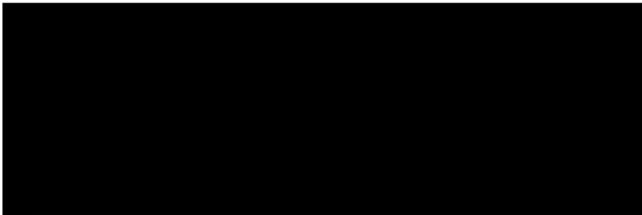

It has been allowed to grow too large over the years and branches at the top have been broken off by the wind from time to time. Looking at the tree from my study window as I write I cannot see any way that it can be cut back and shaped in an acceptable or attractive way that will still look like a birch tree as the trunk is fairly thick once the top quarter or third has been cut off. I would have no objection if the tree were cut down and replaced by something more appropriate.
