Dear Sirs

As I explained in my earlier submission, dated 25 November 2019, I am very concerned to read about Rabbi Katz' plans for moving from 47 Fairfax Road to the larger double-unit property at 35-37 Fairfax Road, to extend the reach of the synagogue he has been running (illegally?) at No 47 where he has been an inconsiderate neighbour. His transgressions include noise, total disregard of the regulated opening hours, rubbish being piled high externally, food waste discarded on the slip road which encourages rats etc etc.

His latest plans for the synagogue mention the large, and increased, numbers expected, and exponentially-increased hours. If allowed to go ahead, he will have a two-storey property situated within the same building as many residents' homes: when buying them they could have had absolutely NO expectation of a religious meeting house with extended hours, many visitors and late-night noise, being their immediate neighbour within their block of flats!
