I write regarding the planning application for 35-37 Fairfax Road, NW6, Application Number 2019/4826/P

I have reviewed the Draft Management Plan, Additional Supporting Information and Revised Timetable of Classes, recently submitted in respect of the above application.

The objections I raised to the original planning application remain my view on an unamended basis, even considering the additional documents filed by on 3 March 2020.

I consider that the intended changes and revised plans submitted by the Applicant in support of the application would not be adhered to and within a short space of time, simply ignored by the Rabbi and the Chabad.

There has already been considerable noise due to attendees to the Chabad leaving late, sometimes approaching midnight without consideration of local residents. In addition, the waste/rubbish left outside by the Chabad is unsightly and attracts foxes and vermin, such that often the rubbish is then strewn across the pavement, and on several occasions, the road itself.

Given these events have occurred already, the plans submitted by the Chabad would simply serve to cause more of those same issues.

For the above reasoning, coupled with my original objection, I maintain my position of objecting strongly against the planning application (together with revisions) submitted by the Chabad and Rabbi and ask that the Application be refused.
