| Observations | This variation is acceptable in principle, as long as the proposed replacement windows faithfully follow both the pattern and slim sight-lines of the current steel-framed glazing, retaining any plain narrow coloured glass where it is extant. Putty or silicone should be used to fix the glass (as opposed to metal beading) to ensure that the new frames are appropriate to the existing facade. |
| | The loss of the two stained glass panels on the side elevation is regrettable - this was not well documented in the previous application and had it been more visible we would have objected to it. |
| | We assume that the basement timber sash windows will be retained and refurbished in situ. |
| | In omitting the gap between the facades and extending the hotel bedroom floors we ask for confirmation that the overall size of the hotel use will not be greater than 1000 sq m, otherwise it will not be in conformity with policy E3 and we |
