Having assessed the proposals, I can confirm that TfL has no strategic transport comments to make on this planning application. If the development is permitted I recommend the developer is reminded of the following:

Euston Road forms part of the Transport for London Road Network (TLRN). The footway and carriageway must not be blocked during the development. All vehicles associated with the development must only park / stop at permitted locations and within the time periods permitted by existing on-street restrictions. In the event any Red Route dispensations are sought, these must be agreed with TfL in writing before the work.

Should the applicant wish to carry out any work that would require a highway licence, for example for scaffolding or a hoarding on the footway whilst undertaking this work, separate licences may be required with TfL, please see, <https://www.tfl.gov.uk/info-for/urban-planning-and-construction/highway-licences>
