## THE LONDON IRISH CENTRE (LIC) – COMMUNITY USE PLAN (CUP)

### SECTION ONE: INTRODUCTION

**1.1** The LIC is the largest Irish Centre outside of Ireland and the largest Irish welfare charity in Britain. It is a Community and Cultural Centre, serving local, Irish and London communities with 82,000 users in 2019. We support those most in need, showcase the very best of Irish culture in all its diversity and provide space, facilities and amenities for the local and London communities to gather, connect and strengthen community ties.

The Centre is at a critical point in its history as the needs of our users change. The current building is no longer fit for purpose with annual running costs for the ageing Centre totalling hundreds of thousands. Simply keeping services open is a challenge; our ability to meet the increasing needs of our clients is severely compromised by accessibility issues and old, decaying facilities and we have exhausted the building's potential to generate the income required to support our users.

The vision for the redeveloped LIC is:

- For the vulnerable, forgotten and isolated – high quality wellbeing, advice, outreach and befriending services in the high quality facilities;
- For audiences, artists and students – world-class cultural, recreational and educational spaces and resources;
- For visitors - the Story of the Irish in London will celebrate the story and contribution of the Irish to this city and resonate with other ethnic groups;
- For London and local communities – beautiful new event, meeting and social spaces in which to gather, connect and strengthen community ties;
- For the Charity – financial sustainability for the next 65 years through improved income generation.

**1.2** This CUP is divided into two sections, the first part detailing the current service provision and community use, as well as its impact and the second outlining the community use and impact of a redeveloped LIC.

**1.3** Since 1955 the LIC has been the Irish Heart of London. The iconic and much-loved Centre delivers a diverse mix of community and cultural services to empower and enrich the lives of those it welcomes, from across the Irish, local and London communities. From advice services to art exhibitions, advice services to concerts, the LIC's work is impact-focused, creative and responsive to changing needs. The delivery of our work is calibrated around our **Theory of Change (TOC)**, a framework we use to understand how our services deliver impact to the community, see **Appendix One**.

## SECTION TWO: CURRENT COMMUNITY USE AND IMPACT

**2.1** The LIC's work is focused around three broad areas, **Table 1**:

**2.2 Opening Hours:** The LIC offers a wide range of services and the main building is open 111 hours per week. Due to the fragmented nature of the building, with five separate entrances, the LIC has a range of opening hours, **Table 2**.

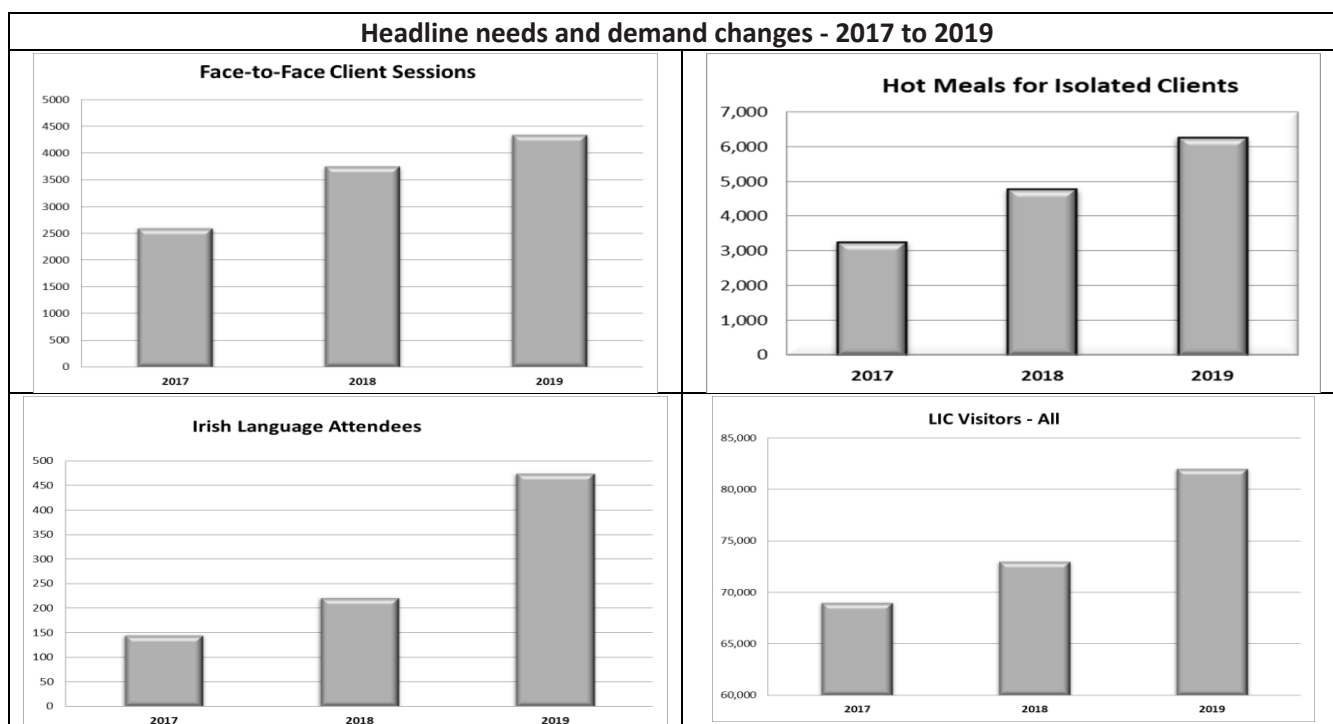
**2.3 LIC's Community Impact:** From advice services to art exhibitions, case work to concerts, the LIC's work is impact-focused, creative and responsive to changing needs. Since 2017 we have been working to develop a robust outcomes management framework across the whole organisation, to define our target outcomes, improve their measurement and provide us with common understanding of what 'good' looks like.

**2.3.1** Demand has increased across all service areas over the past number of years.

Community Services demand has increased as local authority provision has come under increasing pressure due to austerity measures and as the 'loneliness epidemic' intensifies.

Culture 'consumption' is growing in London generally and the LIC has increased the range and variety of its offer. The LIC responded to the closure of Camden's popular Camden Centre by supporting many of its former users with space hire and facilities.

Commercial and social enterprise usage has risen due to the quality and affordability of the LIC's rates. In general the LIC can no longer cope with the demand for its services. **Figure 1**, below, highlights key changes in 2017 to 2019.



**Appendix Two** shows the key service impact data across the LIC for 2019.

## 2.4. The LIC's Current Community Use

**2.4.1 Introduction:** The LIC attracts a wide range of organisations, clients and customers. Of the 82,000 who visited in 2019, we estimate that 75% are non-Irish. From our client data we know that 40% of our Advice and Outreach clients are non-Irish and we estimate, of the 19,000 who attend Culture, Arts and Education, 35% are non-Irish. In total 1,355 events were held in 2020 (this excludes the Day Centre/Wellbeing Services Programme of activities, which total another 500+) .

## SECTION THREE: FUTURE COMMUNITY USE AND IMPACT (2023 onwards)

**3.1. Introduction:** We wish to continue to support those most in need, showcasing the very best of Irish culture in all its diversity and providing space, facilities and amenities for the local and London communities to gather, connect and strengthen community ties. A redeveloped building will allow us to improve the quantity, quality and diversity of the services in a way which is both environmentally and economically sustainable. The improved economic sustainability will allow us to offer an increased range of free and subsidised services directly provided by the LIC as well as an increase in the volume of the free and heavily discounted space provided to neighbourhood and community groups.

**3.2** The LIC's work will continue to be focused around the current three broad areas as below and the detailed table in 2.1.

- Community Services
- Culture, Arts and Education
- Social Enterprise and Commercial

**3.3 Future Community Use:** We anticipate the LIC's diverse and wide ranging community use will include the following, **Table 3**.

**3.4 Opening Hours:** A redeveloped LIC will have one main entrance where everyone is welcome, be they service users or people attending events. The opening hours are anticipated to remain the same for the main Centre facilities with Advice and Outreach, and Day Centre/Wellbeing changing as previously detailed, in Table 3, above.

#### 4. CONCLUSION

4.1 Since 1955 the London Irish Centre has welcomed, supported, cared for and connected but the needs of those we serve are changing with demands increasing, and expectations rising. The social environment in which we work is changing rapidly, with increasing numbers living alone and with a rapidly ageing population. The ageing Centre simply cannot keep up.

However, our vision for the London Irish Centre is not driven by the inadequacy of what we do now, but the potential of what more we can do in the future.

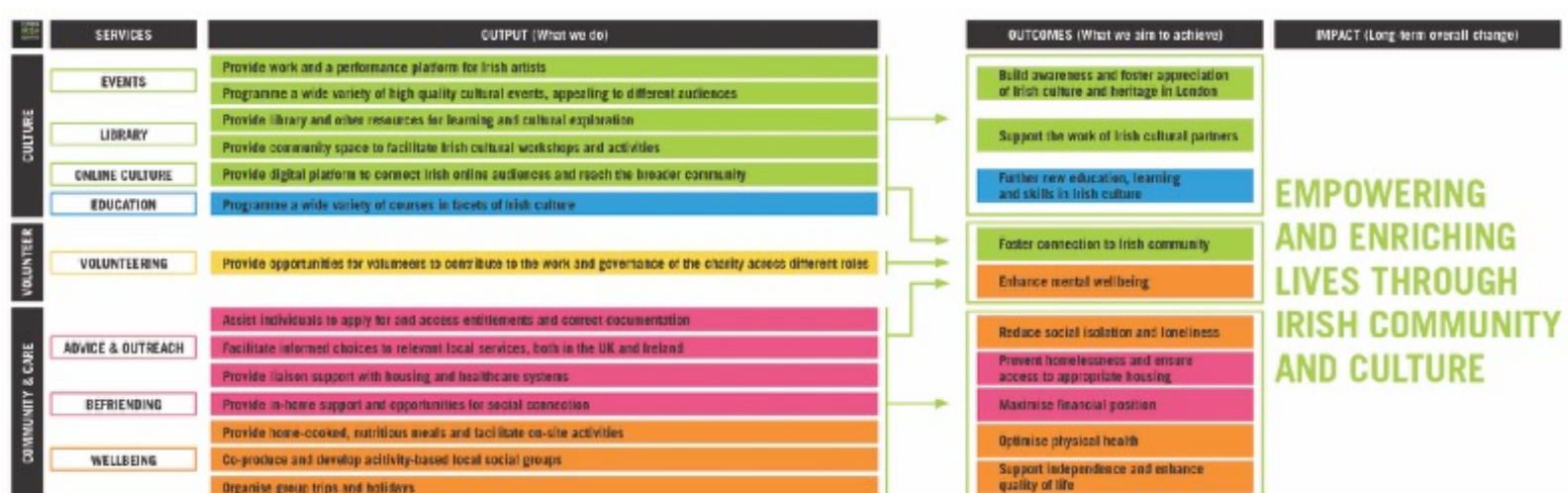
