The visual impact on the CA will be minimal from Elsworthy Road or Primrose Hill Road and the view from Primrose Hill is blighted far more by the Adelaide Road Tower blocks or even the low St Paul's School buildings. However adverse the visual impact might be considered by a few, it is far outweighed by the environmental benefit resulting from the renewable energy generated.
