Detailed drawings have been submitted showing the new windows for the rear extension in accordance with the requirements of condition 4b. No details for the existing historic windows have been submitted which would be retained and repaired in-situ in accordance with condition 5 of 2016/4688/P. The drawings have been provided to show the elevations, sections and jambs of each window.
