Proposal: Variation of condition 1 (approved drawings) and removal of condition 2 (louvre screens) of planning permission reference 2019/1896/P dated 27/06/2019 (amendment of 2016/7041/P dated 21/04/2017) for the 'erection of mansard roof extension and single storey rear infill extension; replacement of 4 x rear sash windows with matching windows; lowering of ground floor level by 15cm; installation of new French doors and bricking up of existing door within front lightwell; removal of metal staircase and replacement with a platform lift'; namely, the removal of louvre screens from rear infill extension roof.
