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Dear Ms Hazelton,

My wife, Sandra, and I would like to raise our very strong objections to the above-mentioned planning application. We are resident at Flat 2, 95 Redington Road, NW3 7RR. We feel that what is proposed is completely inappropriate in size and scale etc for the plot, as well as having an aesthetic character wholly out of keeping with its surroundings. Additionally, it will result in a substantial loss of trees and hedges on the site, which will spoil the views and feel of the area for all of those of us who live around it, resulting in a loss of aesthetic amenity for the whole neighbourhood. The plans additionally appear to be wholly insufficiently respectful of the listed swimming pool in its midst, involving unjustifiable changes to the use of key features. Finally, we do not feel that these plans have been adequately publicised to the surrounding neighbours and feel sure that, if they were, there would be many more objections.

In short if this is allowed to proceed as currently envisaged, we shall be deeply disappointed and believe it will make a mockery of any avowed commitment on the part of Camden Council to the appropriate preservation of the conservation area of which this is a part and within which we reside.
