Tusa	07/04/2020 18:37:46	COMMNT	<p>We wish to register our strong opposition to these works.</p> <p>These three trees were originally planted to replace two mature Lime trees that the previous owner applied to fell in order to increase the amount of parking space.</p> <p>The application was strongly opposed at the time, and approval was only given on the basis that these three trees would be replanted and allowed to mature.</p> <p>The statement in the application that the site "has been overplanted" is an assertion only, and ignores the history of the site, and of that entire side of Christchurch Hill, which has always had closely planted trees to prevent overlooking by and into the back of Gainsborough Gardens.</p> <p>Allowing these trees to be felled would further remove maturing trees from the upper end of this part of Christchurch Hill, with no corresponding improvement to the public amenity either on the site or elsewhere.</p>
