It should also be mentioned that the consultants' studies relate to the effects of noise on residents inside their dwellings. There will be other receptors, in the open air, notably members of the public who walk along the canal towpath, which is closer than the nearest dwellings. The canal can be a place of quietude, and its users are entitled to peace and quiet. Moreover, the arches are not a point source but cumulative; they run parallel to the towpath, so the loudspeakers will impact the length of a walk along the towpath.
