**Application for Planning Permission to develop telecommunications equipment at 25 Hampstead High Street by NET Coverage Solutions and Cornerstone**

I have been notified by Pegasus of their intention to make the above application on behalf of NET Coverage Solutions (NETCS) and Cornerstone. I want to register my objection to this development as someone who **lives and works within two metres** of the proposed telecommunications masts.

My objection is based on the following key points, which I shall discuss further below:

1. Incorrect application
2. Health risks of extreme proximity of telecommunications masts to a significant number of residential dwellings
3. Alternative development
4. Lack of clarity on exclusion zones
5. Unsightly development in a conservation area

**1. Incorrect Application**

Pegasus has stated that it intends to make an application for 25 Hampstead High Street. This is a one storey commercial premises formerly occupied by Nat West Bank. From the drawings they have provided, their actual intention is to site the masts at 25-26 Hampstead High Street, a five storey residential property.

**2. Residential Area – Health Risks**

As stated above, 25-26 Hampstead High Street is a residential property whose occupants include young families, as do the many residential properties within 100m of the proposed mast site. My home is on the fifth floor of the building, immediately beneath the flat roof on which the masts would be sited. I live and work at this address and would therefore have almost constant exposure
