Due to recent dry weather trees have been absorbing moisture through their roots from the London clay subsoil which is removed moisture causing shrinkage. This is an annual process as noted by this report and others. A number of these applications have come before the planning committee in recent weeks. The solution has always been removal of the offending trees without a clear reference to a policy strategy provided by Camden. Can this please be addressed? Multiple applications of this sort will continue to arise and will need to be managed in a consistent and transparent and nature. Can Camden and it's gardening and Engineering resources please produce a strategy which will provide a clear way to protect trees in line with the Camden carbon neutral policy but also to protect homeowners. In this way as much reuse and recycling of existing shrubs can be achieved with the potential for reuse across the borough in Camden estates and parks or open areas. This application is one which highlights the growing problem of similar applications which are currently dance with on a piecemeal basis but need an overall strategy.
