disabled lift, front dormer mode. (AO) OBJ

No objection to the rear extension or front dormer change. The side extension with lift is awkwardly
designed and the lift both in size and materials far too prominent at this highly visible corner.

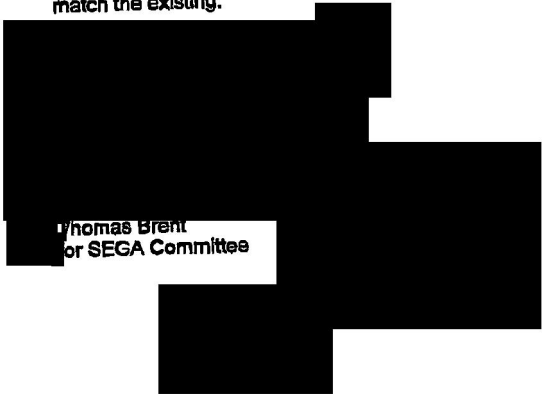
* Application No. PWX 0302305/P-25 Nassington Road NW3. Enlargement to existing projecting
