

Design notes:

This drawing shows AB section through the clad feature wall. Suspended from the wall is a wooden bench supported on steel brackets from behind and the sides, to give it the impression of floating.

The wall is constructed of hollow HD concrete blocks with rebar. The foundations for the wall should be specified by a Structural Engineer, due to its height and the fact that bamboo is growing behind it. The foundations should be protected by root protection membrane to a depth of 600mm and projecting 300mm above the soil level. The wall is clad in pavers to match the paving of the patio. The exact specification for this and its fixing can be determined when the material is finalised.

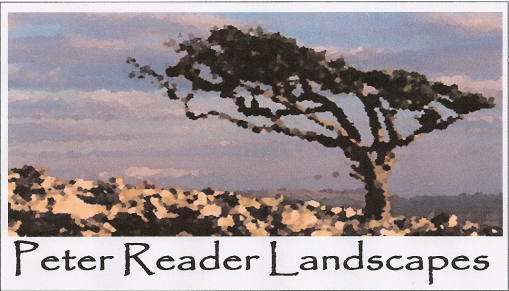
Additionally a bespoke concrete sculpture will be fixed to the front of the wall. Specialist advice should be sought to clarify how this will be achieved.

Behind the wall the slat garden fence runs held on posts set in concrete with 600mm of the post buried. To either side of the wall the fence is clad in Western Red Cedar horizontal trellis.
