

Design notes:

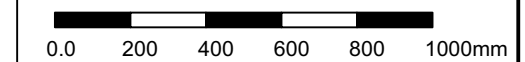
This drawing shows the top view of the bench construction and the metal bracket fixings running out of the feature wall and planter walls that support it.

The bench is constructed from hardwood (Western Red Cedar or Iroko) to match the bespoke trellis on either side.

The bench is enclosed in a frame which is constructed of beams approx 50mm wide x 70mm deep. At the front this frame will have a groove routed into it to accept an LED strip light that will light under the bench at night.

Support struts run from back to front across this frame to provide supports to the seating slats that make up the seating surface. These struts also serve to hide the metal brackets that support the bench and provide its 'floating' appearance.

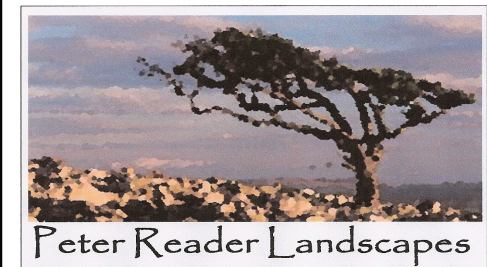
