Proposal:

Installation of 12x antenna apertures, 4x 600mm diameter dishes, 7x equipment cabinets and supporting steelwork at roof level. Installation 1x cabinet at ground-level, plus ancillary development.

The Council has considered your application for prior approval of siting and appearance in respect of the telecommunications equipment described above determines that prior approval is required and hereby **refuses approval** for the following reasons.

Reason(s) for Objection


- 1 The proposal, by reason of the location, scale, height and design, would result in a proliferation of visual rooftop clutter which would cause harm to the character and appearance of the host property, wider streetscene and the setting of the adjacent listed building, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
