T1 - Lime Tree - Crown Reduce in height by approx 6m and balance the lateral spread where required by approx 2m.

This tree has been previously worked on. The new house has been partially built around this tree under strict guidance by the tree officer but having pruned the tree late last year we noted some serious issues which needed a more indepth climbing inspection by Simon Pryce to evaluate its structural intergrity. It's regretful the final conclusion as provided in the enclosed report is that the tree should in fact come down. This is due to historically poor pruning practise and the major onset of decay in the main stem where there is a large open cavity at the crown break. There was a secondary temporary option put forward which was to reduce the height of it considerably to remove weight and for the continual maintenance at this lower height with ongoing observations. This point of reduction is shown on the attached photo as a yellow line. This recommendation was simply to prolong its life for as long a period of time as possible whilst the end result still remains that it will need to come down in due course as the decay will continue. My clients are keen to try the latter option.
