My children and I live right opposite this site across the canal.</p> <p>When planning for building this site was requested we as residents were assured at meetings that the applicants did not wish to nor will they be seeking to make any noise related issues, obviously that it seems was not really the case.</p> <p>Speakers outside businesses create a lot of noise nuisance to local residents, who in turn are made to feel like they are eccentric or just constant complainers if they contact the authorities.
