Pictures are available. The builders have shown complete contempt for the RPAs, piling up materials on the trees' roots including RSJs, and leaning materials and tools up against the tree trunks.</p> <p>The latest application to fell three lime trees provides a plan for replanting that also shows garden buildings whose concrete foundations are already laid, prior to any planning application or permission, and right over the RPAs of the limes trees. It is supposed that now the same builders' contempt for the trees is operating while they drive the machinery to build these buildings past the trees.</p> <p>While the sycamore has already been felled along with 7 other trees in the last few years in an attempt to completely clear the entire garden of trees, the limes are still there and need urgent protection.</p> <p>Please refuse this request to sign off the conditions to this planning consent and investigate the illegal building at the rear of the garden.</p> <p>[REDACTED]</p>
