



TREE SCHEDULE:
As proposed by Nick Bell LB Camden Tree & Landscape Officer, 24th May 2019:

- Liriodendron tulipifera** single stem 16-18cm watering bag 53Litres.
- Cercis siliquastrum** single stem 16-18cm watering bag 53L.
- Salix babylonica** single stem, 16-18 cm watering bag 53L.
- Cornus eddie white wonder** 16-18cm watering bag 53L.
- Cercidiphyllum japonicum**, single stem 16-18cm watering bag 53L.
- Salix babylonica** single stem, 16-18 cm watering bag 53L.
- Acer campestre streetwise** 16-18cm watering bag. (At the back of the benches, one in line with the gap and one at the northern end of the benches)
- Magnolia Kobus** single stem 18-20cm watering bag 53L.
- Liquidambar styraciflua**, single stem 16-18 watering bag 53L.
- Crataegus monogyna stricta** 16-18cm watering bag 53L. (Even spacing, spread out to fit the space)
- Metasequoia glyptostroboides**, single stem, 16-18cm, watering bag 53L.

• For all the trees we would consider necessary an established aftercare programme of at least 3 years. Watering of 53L per week per tree from April to October for the 3 years and any necessary maintenance to remove weeds from the tree pit, aerating the soil and minimal formative pruning if required to promote a health growth. Please note it is unlikely that the council's tree section and its term tree contractor will have the capacity to undertake the watering/young tree maintenance.

• Soil cells should be used where possible where trees are proposed in hard surfaces
