Instead, the comparably large expanse of the hard-landscaped side drive makes for a more natural location for such functions as refuse. The proposed boxed bike storage looks as if grafted onto the front of the side extension, a bigger and bulkier version of the current, cobbled-up lean-to. A better designed refuse together with the bike storage enclosure, would create a more suitable addition to this service wing to the original Villa. The two large glass-balustraded terraces, one on the ground, the other of the first floor could provide the sight of the windows of the next-door building and so amount to the loss of privacy. Finally, this appears to be more suitable for a change of use application with seemingly at least a ground floor and upper floors housing unit(s).
