The Council has considered your application and decided to grant approval of details.

Informatives:

1 Reason for granting permission-

The approved roof terrace on the 9th floor of the office building fronting Charlotte Street included a glass balustrade measuring 1.1m high in front of the reception atrium. The proposal includes a change to the material and height of the screen from glass balustrades to two timber slatted screens measuring 2.25m in height in the same location as the approved glass balustrades.

The purpose of the timber screen would be to conceal the plant area from the accessible roof terrace. The height of the screen would be increased by 1.1m and the material would change from glass to timber however in views from the adjacent streets the timber screens would remain invisible due to the extent of the setbacks at the upper floors. The details would be sufficient to satisfy the

parameters of the condition.

As such the proposed details are in general accordance with policy C5 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, policy DP26 of Camden Council's Development Policies, and the London Plan policy 5.21.

You are advised that all conditions relating to planning permission granted on 30/03/2016 (ref 2015/7017/P) which need details to be submitted, have been approved.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2019.
