TAKE NOTICE.



- Before beginning to lay or dig out the foundation of any house or building, or to rebuild any house or building, seven days' notice in writing shall be given to the Borough Council by the person intending to build or rebuild such house or building. (Sec. 39, Public Health (London) Act, 1936.)
- Before making any drain for the purpose of draining directly or indirectly into any sewer, seven days' notice in writing shall be given to the Borough Council by the person intending to make such drain. (Sec. 39, Public Health (London) Act, 1936.)
- Every builder who is about to execute any work as defined in these by-laws shall serve upon the Sanitary Authority at least 24 hours' notice in writing of the day and time at which such work is to be commenced together with such detailed descriptions as shall sufficiently describe the proposed work. (By-laws London County Council (water closets, &c., and the proper accessories thereof), 1930, and Public Health (London) Act, 1936.)
- Every person about to construct, reconstruct or alter any drainage work, shall deposit in duplicate, 7 days before the work is commenced, the plans, sections and particulars necessary for the purpose of ascertaining whether such construction, reconstruction, or alteration will be in accordance with statutory provisions and by-laws. Such persons shall also serve at least 24 hours' notice in writing of the day and time at which the work is to be commenced. (Drainage By-Laws, London County Council, 1934, and Public Health (London) Act, 1936.)

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
