Having had a previous conversation with a Planning Officer in your department I have been assured that a Planning Permission Application is not required in this case as there is no immediate structural work being undertaken to the original fabric of the building and there will be no change of use to the building. If it is decided that Planning Permission is however required please can you inform us immediately to ensure that we do not loose any more time in the application process.

The property is going to remain under Class A1 as a sandwich shop. The work to be undertaken only consists of inserting display fridges, a counter and seating areas on the ground floor and the basement is to be converted into a preparation area with an office and W.C area.

The only structural work to be undertaken would be to remove the temporary suspended ceilings currently in the ground floor to reveal and restore the original ceiling.
