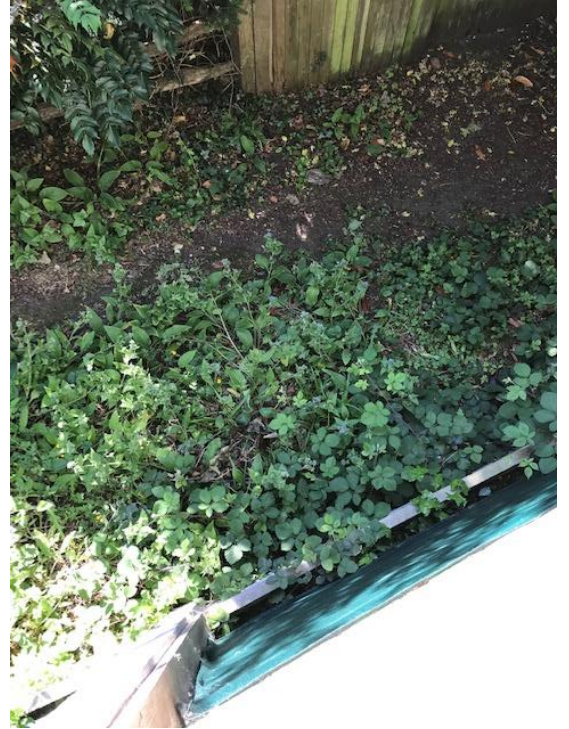


Silver Birch at 3 Oak Hill Way

Trunk proximity to my fence



Drop down to path on other side of fence (approx. 2metres below my garden level)



There is a rubber play surface next to the tree. The tree has thrown out lateral roots in an attempt to anchor itself. These roots are immediately below the play surface. The lighter veins in the pictures below show where the raised roots are pushing up the play surface (in places several cms high). The roots haven't penetrated down into the garden but are resting between the play surface and its sub surface above the level of the soil. It feels very unstable.
